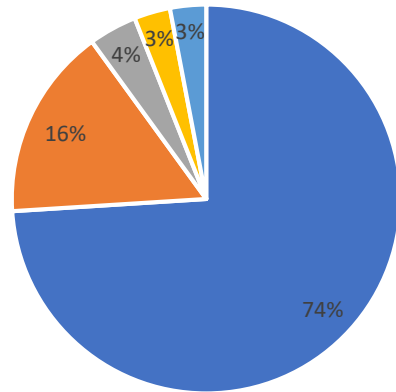
Summary of Responses

Key responses:

- 90% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that their child is happy at Ifield School.
- 90% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that their child is safe at Ifield School.
- 85% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that their child progresses well at Ifield School.
- 87% of parents/carers would recommend Ifield School to another parent.
- 77% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that their child experiences a wide variety of learning opportunities.
- 85% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that behaviour is consistently well-managed by staff.
- 86% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that Ifield School has clear routines and expectations for the behaviour of all pupils across all aspects of school life.
- 90% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that Ifield School has a positive, respectful culture in which their child is cared for.
- 84% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that communication from the school is effective and timely.

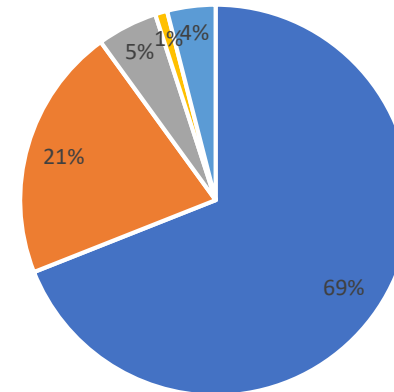

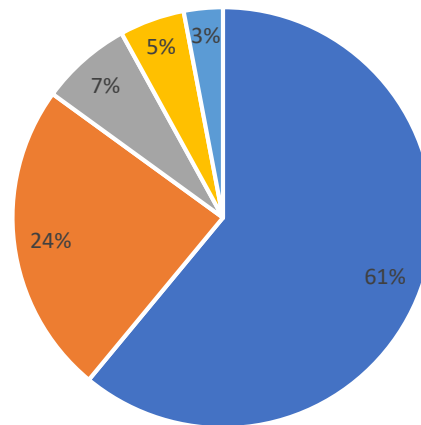

My child is safe at Ifield School

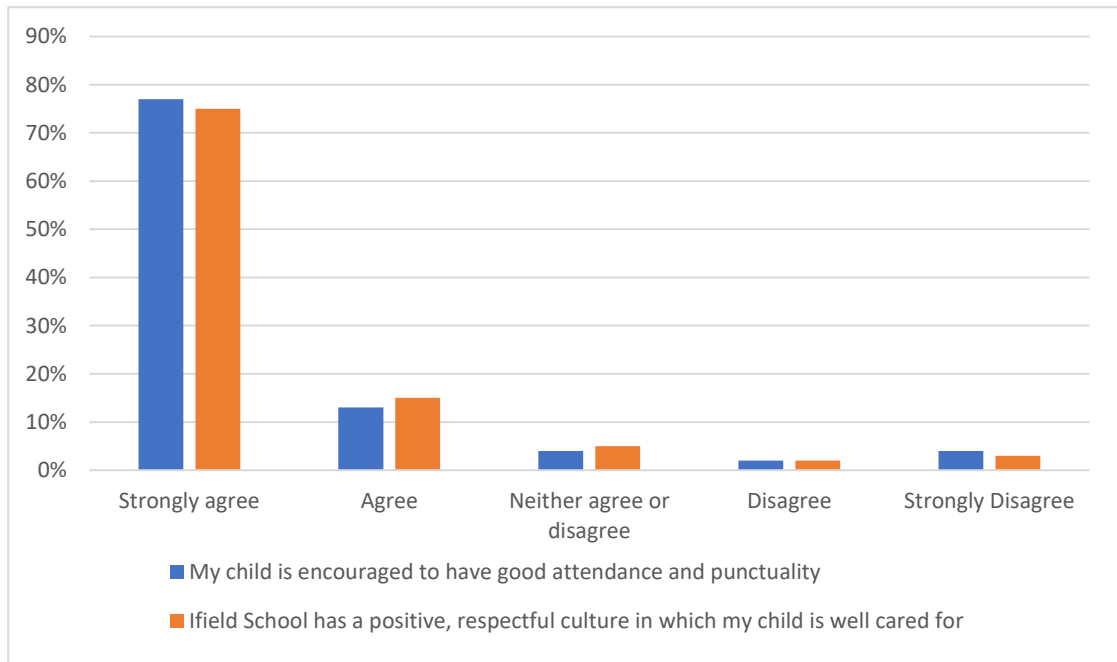
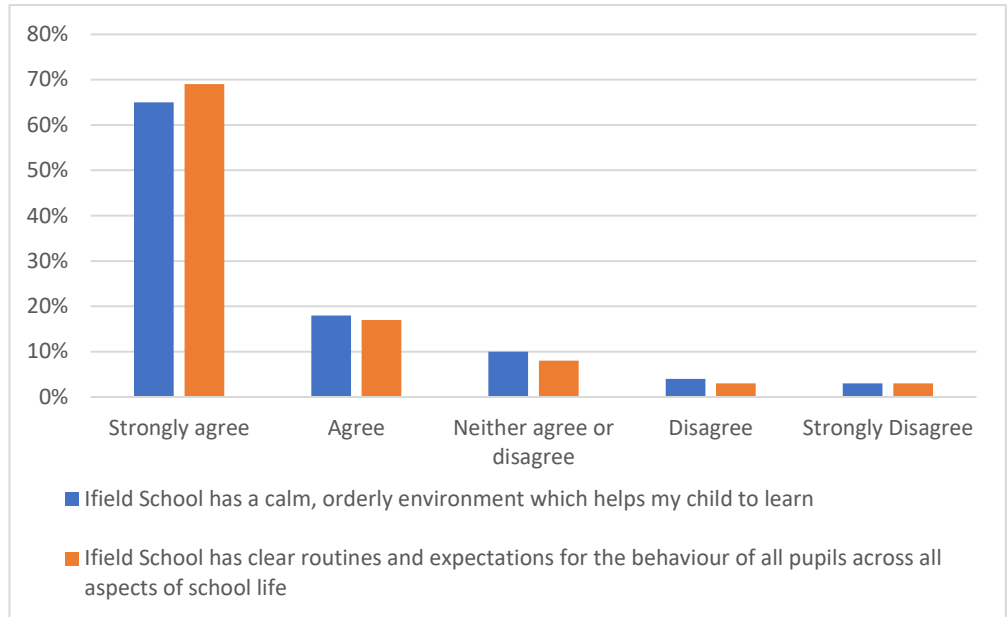
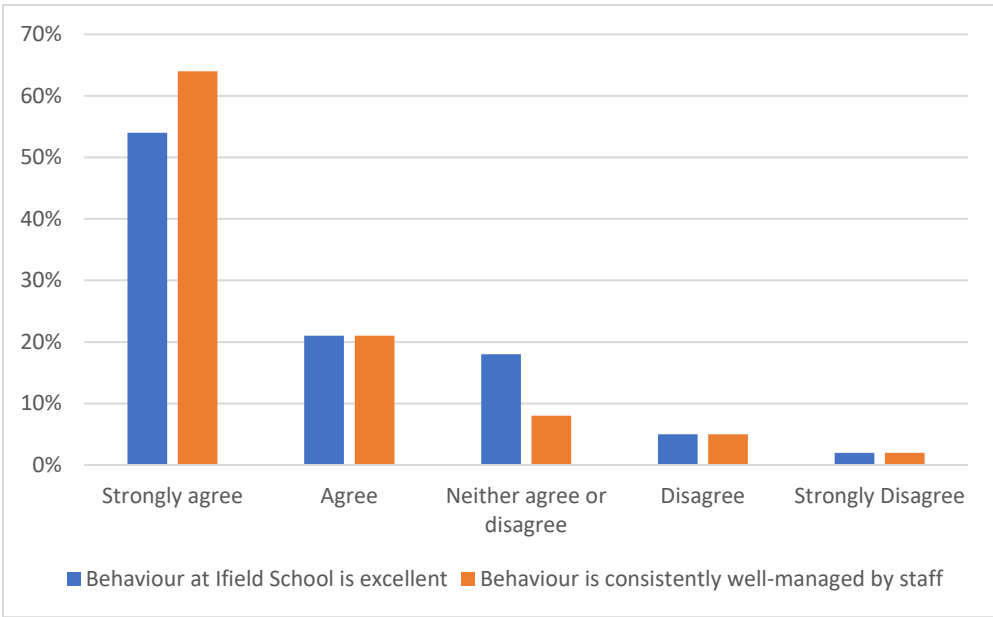

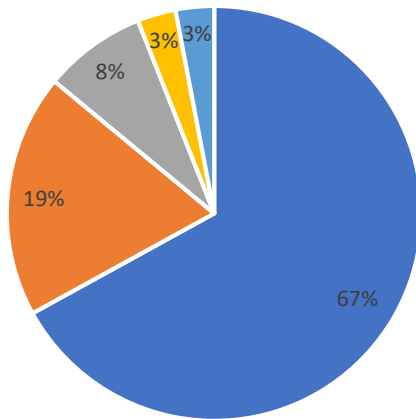
My child progresses well at Ifield School

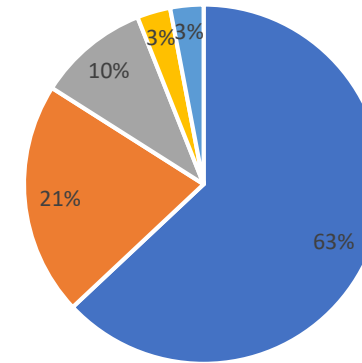


My child enjoys going to Ifield School



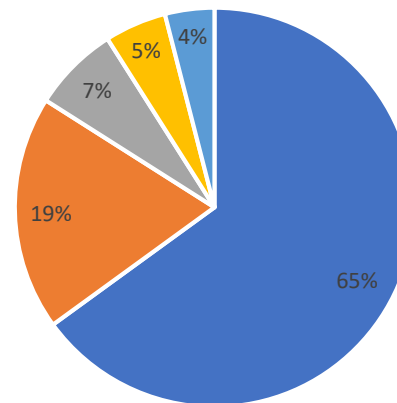
