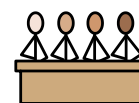


Safeguarding Policy

must read and understand.



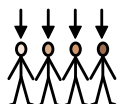

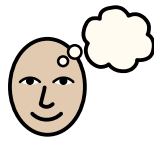




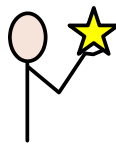
What does safeguarding mean?



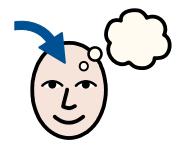
At Ifield School, adults think your health, safety and



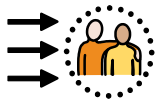
happiness are very important.



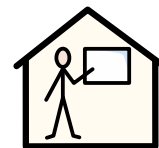
Adults will help you recognise risks and learn

Staff and Visitors



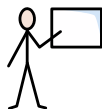
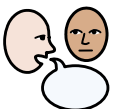
All staff and visitors to Ifield School have to sign in at the



office and wear a lanyard or a sticker.

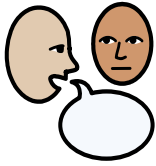


Tell an adult if you see someone in school who is not



wearing a lanyard or a sticker.

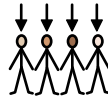
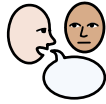




If you need to talk - we will listen

Trying to give you cigarettes, vapes or alcohol

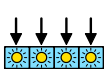


Hitting you or hurting you
