The Summer terms always provide fantastic opportunities to see you all at the wide variety of events we have planned. All dates for the next two terms will be shared within April's Newsletter.

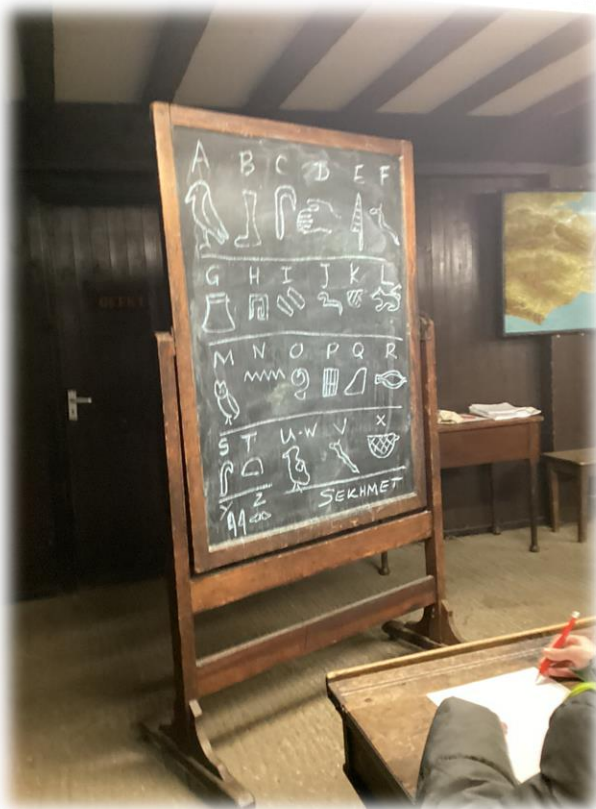
Our first special event of this term is taking place at the School Woodlands this Saturday and I hope to see as many of you as possible.
