Welcome to Heron class! We have 15 students in our class, aged year 7 to year 9. This term our topic is called Time Travellers; which we will incorporate into all areas of the curriculum.

## English:

In English pupils will be developing their writing skills through a range of different genre e.g. Story writing, recounts, instructions and non-fiction reports.

Pupils will be improving their phonic skills through Little Wandle Letters and Sounds.

Our daily reading sessions will include a range of tasks e.g. Guided Reading sessions and Individual Reading sessions.

We will be following a number of texts which link to our topic of time travellers such as How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth, The Dinosaur who Pooped the Past and Stig of the Dump.

Pupils will be learning about multiplication and division, money, length, capacity and temperature in maths.



## History:

Pupils will be learning about pre-historic times including when the dinosaurs roamed the Earth.



#### Science:

Pupils will be learning about soil and rocks and will be exploring the properties of both of these. They will also be looking at what conditions seeds need to grow.

#### Art:

Pupils will be exploring art work in caves and be creating their own art work using different media.

### Food Tech:

The pupils will be making a range of items related to breakfasts on Thursday morning.



## Life Skills:

This term we are developing our self help skills around the home including; making the bed, being safe in the kitchen and being responsible for our own belongings.

We will also have a weekly computing lesson, allowing pupils to upskill their ICT skills.


## PSHE (Personal, social and health education):
