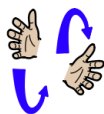


## Core signs for our topic this term.

Mountain



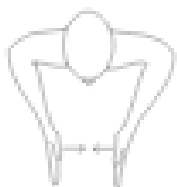

Pupils will be developing a range of independence skills, including personal care, such as hand washing and hair brushing.

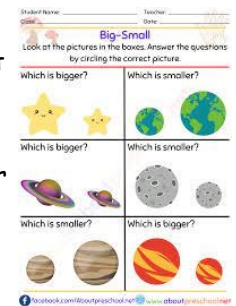
## Communication

Magpie class pupils will be focussing on routines and prompts. Pupils will develop their understanding of the routines of the day and identifying cues for different activities.

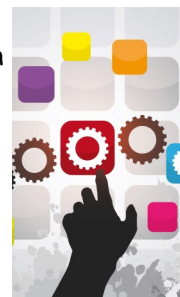


## PSED/Citizenship/RSE
