PE Enrichment this term will take place every Thursday afternoon.

General Information:

Welcome to Term 6, our final term this academic year. Our topic this term will be 'Hop, Skip and Jump'. We are looking forward to using our outside spaces to explore physical activities and learning about the history of different activities.

Literacy and Phonics

In Literacy we will focus on the texts: 'Ready, Steady, Go...' by Celeste Cartright and 'On Your Marks Get Set Gold' by Jon Allen and 'The story of Olympics' by Minna Lacey. We will explore the features of the text and create a range of writing linked to rules of equipment for games and how sports events have a commentator.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be continuing to develop our place value skills. Some pupils will also look at statistics. We will develop our skills of telling the time and explore language that we use to describe position.

Science

This term in Science we will be continuing to learn about the body where we will now focus on exercise and how this affects us. We will also learn about healthy eating, comparing healthy and unhealthy and how we can achieve a balanced diet. We will also learn about personal hygiene and what this means.



Computing

This term in Computing we will be creating our own games and debugging them through editing and improving them. We will also test games from our peers and talk about how they may be improved.



Art and Design & Technology

In Art and Design we will be using different materials to make medals, linking to our focus for our topic. We will also learn about how we can use different methods to make a statue or a trophy.



Food Tech:

In Food Technology we will be focusing on creating summer dishes.

We will be making different types of salads that include a variety of ingredients.



History

In History we will be learning about the history of the Olympics. We will be exploring the different events for participants and compare them to our Sports Day.



PSHE (Personal, social and health education) and RSE

In PSHE we will be identifying what personal information is and learning to recall our own. We will explore different ways of sharing information and how we can keep it safe. We will also identify what passwords are and why we use them.

Physical Education

This term we will be focusing on:

Athletics

We will be developing a variety of skills, such as: running, throwing, jumping, balance, strength and flexibility. We will also think about how we can improve our skills further.

Religious Education

Our key question we will be continuing to learn about this term is: 'Which people are special and why?'

We will be learning about different people or leaders that are special within different beliefs and religions.

PE Enrichment

This term, PE Enrichment will be every Thursday afternoon and activities pupil had for term 5 will carry on for term 6.

Music

Pupils will learn about the 'Rock and Roll' music genre, experiencing songs from the 50's and 60's eras.

Pupils will work as a team to perform 'Rock Around The Clock' using the hand jive, rock rhythms and walking bass lines on the keyboards.
