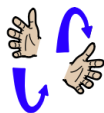
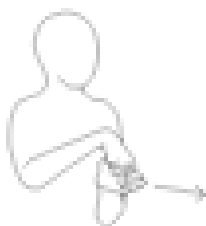

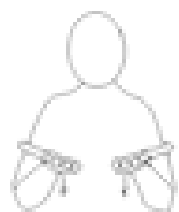

Interventions

Preparing for adulthood

Pupils will be developing their independence skills around washing and bathing.

Communication

Pupils will work on personalised speech and language targets. Pupils will be using a range of communication strategies, such as Intensive Interaction and use of E-Tran and Auditory Scanning books as well as switches.



Maths

Magpie class pupils will be developing counting skills, through number songs, 1:1 correspondence and the concept of 'more'. We will also be exploring 2D and 3D shapes.
