Outcome

Understand how to care for animals and wildlife in the garden.

Name: Date: Animal Care Short Course: Module 3 Looking after animals 3A10 other agreed challenge You will need: 1 Turn the cardboard box upside down 2 Find somewhere quiet and sheltered • a cardboard box (Approximately and cut out a hole for the door to place the house in your garden 15cm square) • a carrier bag or bin bag • pair of scissors • old newspaper or dry leaves or folifage 3 Half-fill the inside with torn newspaper 4 Cover the roof of the house in the Place more foliage on top of the or dry leaves/foliage carrier bag to protect it from the rain house to camouflage it

Make a bird feeder

Name: Date: Animal Care Short Course: Module 3 Looking after animals 3A10 other agreed challenge You will need: 1 Cut out a circular hole out of one side 2 Pour the bird seed into the bottle • a plastic bottle of the bottle halfway up filling it up to where the hole starts • a pair of scissors • some string or gardening wire bird seed 3 Find the middle of the string and wrap Tie the bird feeder to a strong branch 4 Tighten the cap over the string and it twice around the top of the bottle make sure the ends are fairly even and leave for the birds to enjoy!
