




On a wild and windy day,

POW!




As it soared into the sky,

to the corners of the world.




Though they searched




Charlie packed

Scarlet Underpants.




Charlie searched the length

But it wasn't wearing Charlie's Underpants.




Charlie was fed up.
