Developing communication – listening and responding.

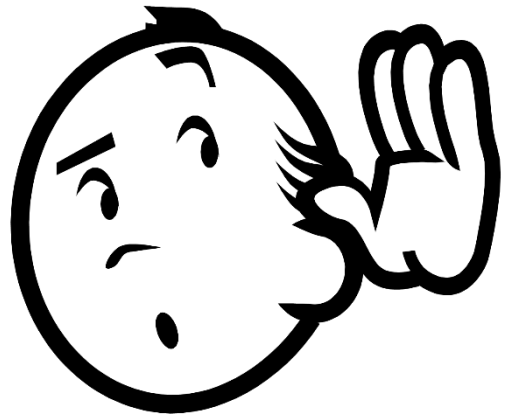

Notices any reactions to see if s/he smiles or shows a preference.

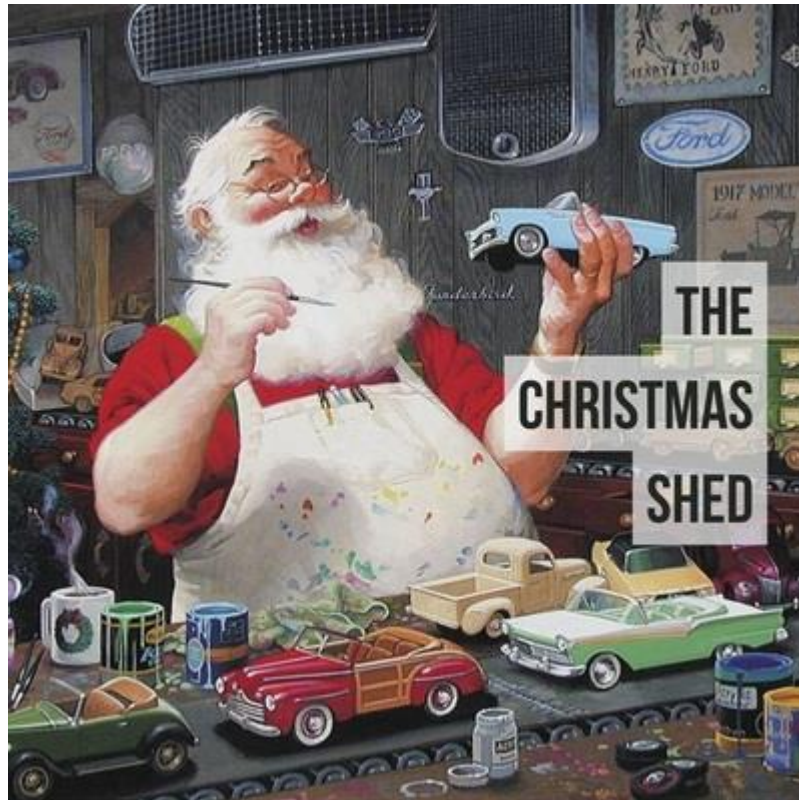


For some fun phonic work go to Crickweb and run the initial sounds game.
