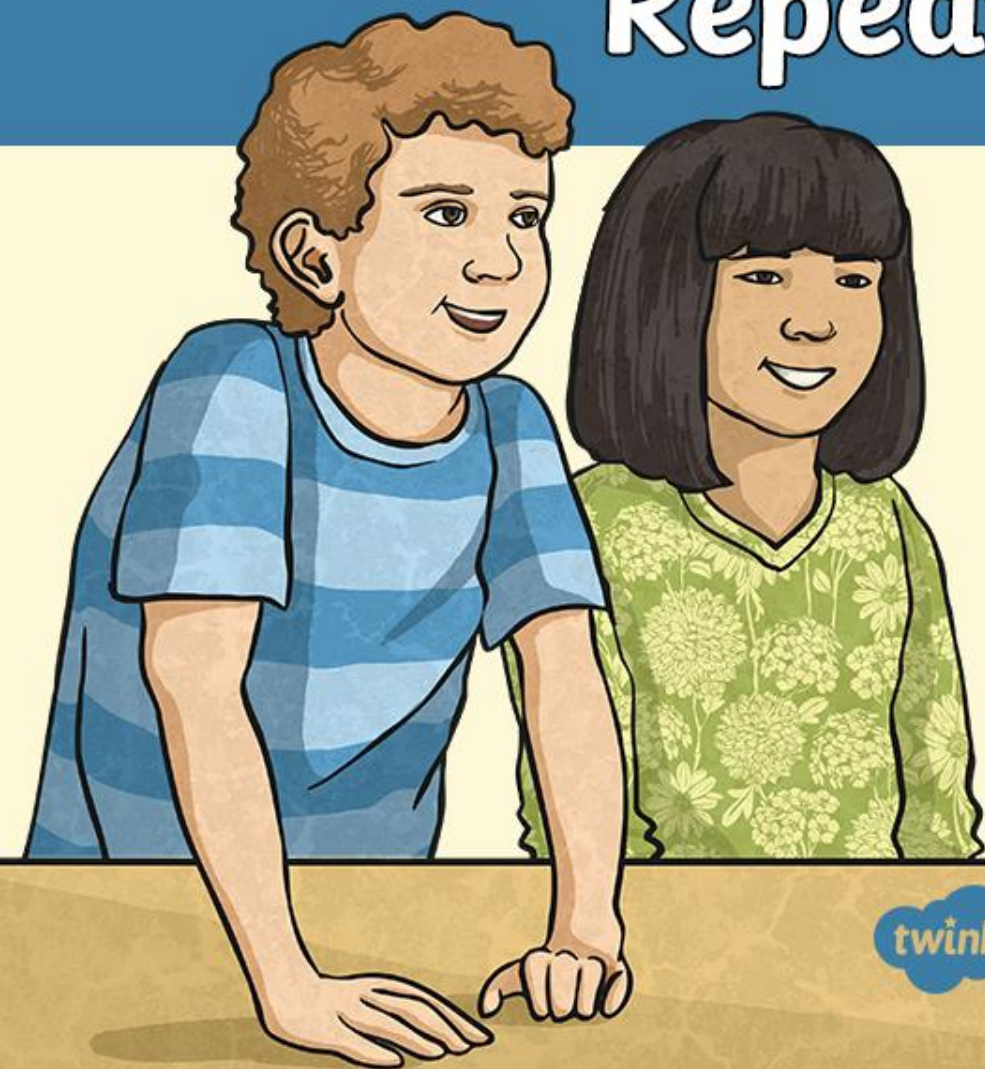
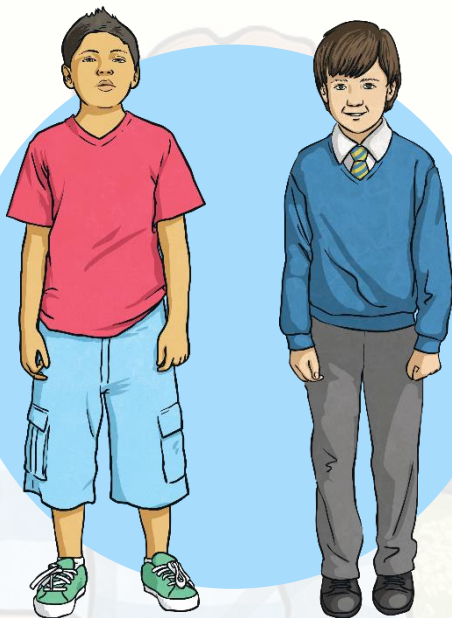


Multiplication as Repeated Addition

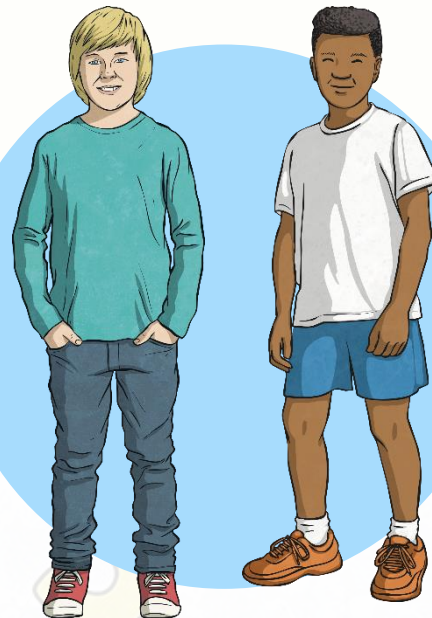


Each boy is wearing 2 shoes. There are 4 boys.

Let's add the shoes.



$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 8$$



How many times do you see the number 2?

4

We can write this sum a different way.

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

Each monkey has 2 bananas. There are 6 monkeys.



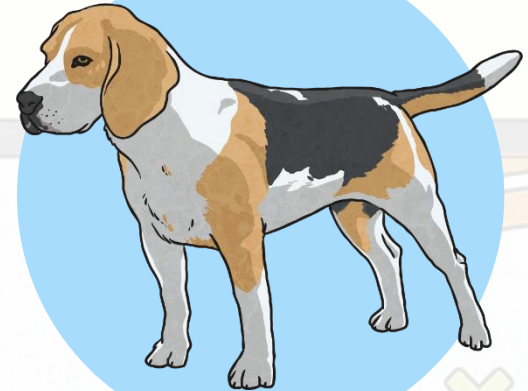
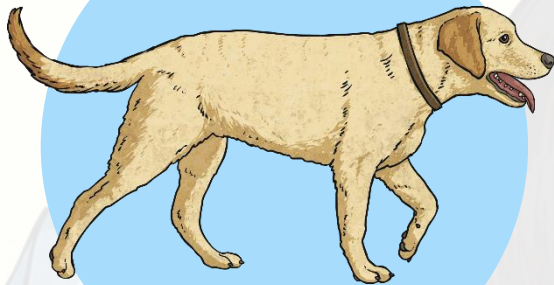
Addition sentence:

$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 12$$

Multiplication sentence:

$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

Each dog has 4 legs. There are 3 dogs here.



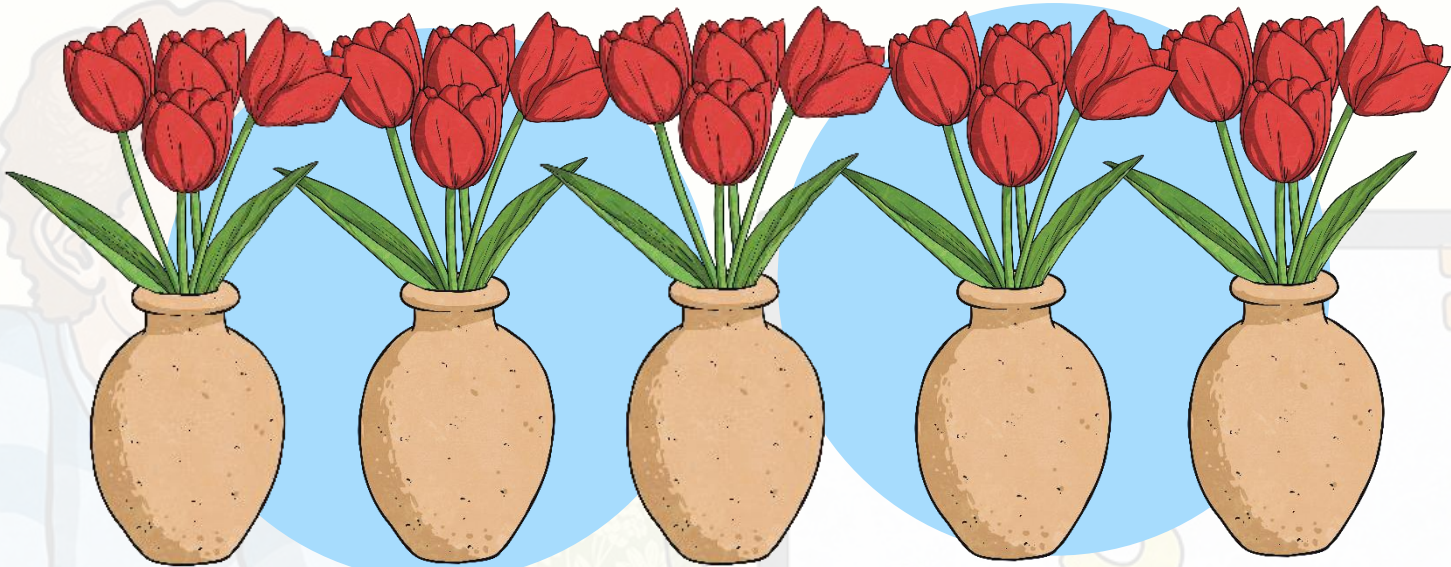
How do we write this as an **addition** sentence?

$$4 + 4 + 4 = 12$$

How do we write it as a **multiplication** sentence?

$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

There are 4 flowers in each vase. There are 5 vases here.



How do we write this as an **addition** sentence?

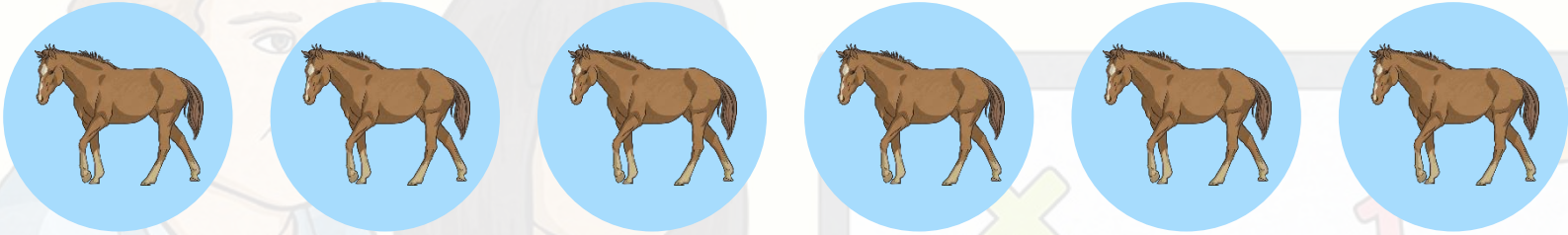
$$4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 20$$

How do we write it as a **multiplication** sentence?

$$5 \times 4 = 20$$

Try these with your partner.

Each horse has 4 legs. There are 6 horses here.



$$4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 =$$

24

How do you write this as a multiplication sentence?

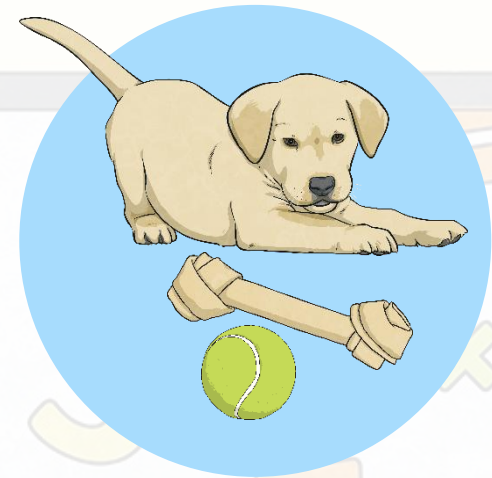
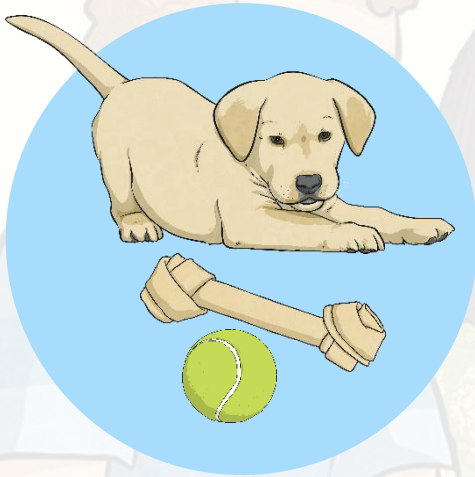
$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

How many legs do the horses have altogether?

24

Try these with your partner.

Sam had 3 puppies. Each puppy had 2 toys.



How many toys were there altogether?

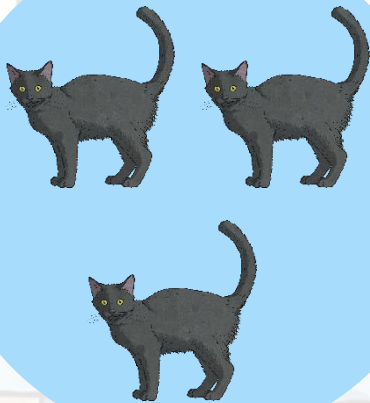
6

How do you write that as a multiplication sentence?

$3 \times 2 = 6$

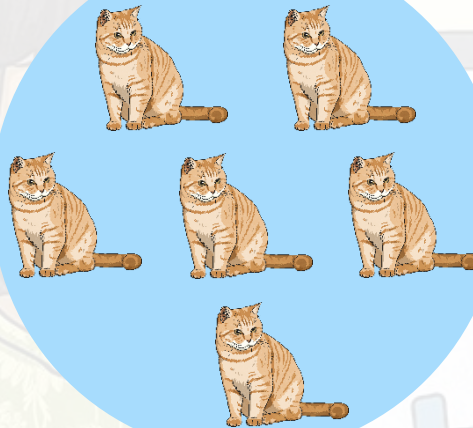
Try these with your partner.

How many legs have...



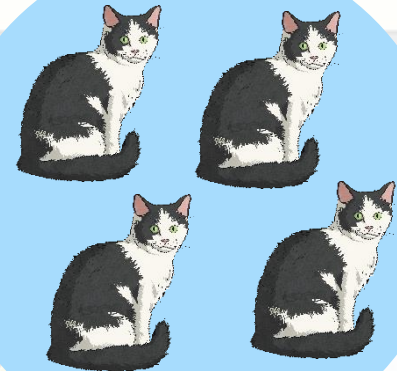
...3 cats?

$$3 \times 4 = 12$$



...6 cats?

$$6 \times 4 = 24$$



...4 cats?
