

Christmas Tree Sensory Bag

Ingredients

Ziplock clear bag	Green food colouring
Permanent marker	Small ornaments, buttons, beads, sparkles, small bells
Duct tape	
Clear hair gel	

Method

1. Draw a Christmas tree on the outside of the bag using the permanent marker. Make it as dark as possible so it can be seen easily.
2. Squeeze in some hair gel. Not too much because then you won't be able to squish the ornaments around.
3. Add the food colouring.
4. Put the ornaments in the bag. How many you add is up to you but too many will make it more difficult to move everything around in the bag.
5. Once all the materials are in the bag, close it up and tape the top so gel and ornaments don't seep out.
6. Then the fun begins. The children can squish the materials together and watch as the green food colouring mixes with the hair gel.
7. Can the children move the ornaments around the bag as they pretend to decorate the Christmas tree?
