<u>Maths</u>

LO: To be able to recall the times tables.

<u>Starter</u>

We have been practicing our times tables this term. We have learned to use multiple addition to help us. E.g.  $3 \times 2 =$  written as 2 + 2 + 2 =. Your child may need to use a 100 square to help them solve the multiplications. This has been included in the resources.

<u>Activities</u>
