LI: To find one more than a given numeral to 20.

- Watch and discuss the PowerPoint *One more than monkey* (easier) or PowerPoint Lesson presentation *Finding one more than numbers to 20*.
- Count from 0 to 20.
- Choose activities appropriate for your child from the **booklet** *One more and one less- activity booklet*. Focus on worksheets with one more only. Leave one less activities for the next day.

Or

encourage your child to complete **Finding one more activity sheet**.

- Challenge your child with questions from the PowerPoint: *Find the number before and after. (Here focus only on slides with one more)*.

Friday

LI: To find one less than a given numeral to 20.

- Watch and discuss the presentation: *Lesson presentation Finding one less than numbers to 20*.
- Model finding one less than numbers on a number line by jumping backwards one space.
- Use the **Number Cards 0-20** and the **0-20 Number Line**. Take turns to turn over one number card from a shuffled stack, then use the number line to find one less. Can your child find one less than a given numeral to 20? Can she/he identify the right number?

- Choose activities appropriate for your child from the **booklet** *One more and one less- activity booklet*. Focus on worksheets with one less only.

Or

invite your child to complete *One more -one less number writing activity sheet*.

Challenge your child with questions from the PowerPoint: *Find the number before and after (Here focus mainly on slides with one less)*.
