






















God decided that he would save Noah by telling him that the flood was coming.
He would instruct Noah to build a really big boat, called an ark.










After Noah had built the ark, God told him to put two of every animal on the earth in it, both male and female.








The waters flooded the earth. Every living thing on the face of the earth was wiped out except for Noah, his family and the animals who were safe in the ark.
