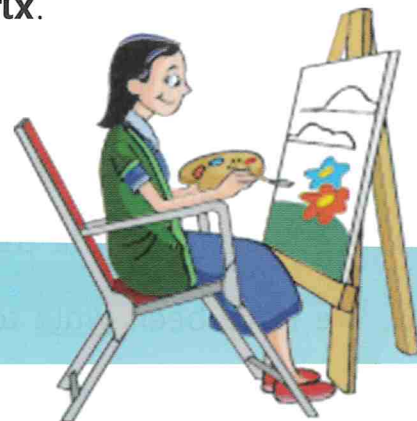


Adding endings to root words (-ed)

We can change words by adding the ending **-ed**.
An ending like this is called a **suffix**.

- I waited for the bus.
- I painted a picture.
