



The Loaves and Fishes

Jesus and his disciples went across the lake on a boat.




But when they got to the other side, another crowd was waiting wanting to hear Jesus speak.



Jesus felt sorry for them and so began to teach them about God.




It started to get late and the crowd were feeling tired and hungry.




Jesus told the disciples they could give the crowd food.
But there were 5000 people! There wasn't enough food.




There was a boy in the crowd who had brought his own food.



There were five loaves and two fishes.




Jesus had the crowd sit in groups of 50 and 100.

Then he broke them and gave them to his disciples.




As the disciples handed out the bread it multiplied and made more bread. The same happened with the fish.
