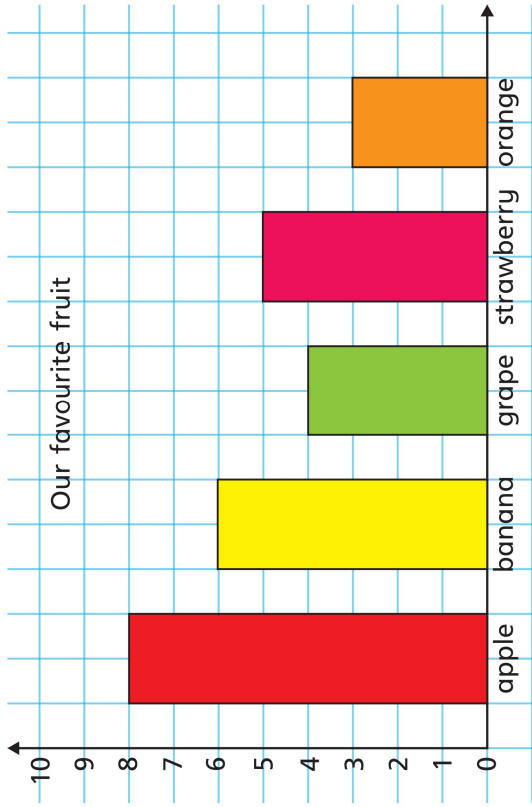


Bar charts

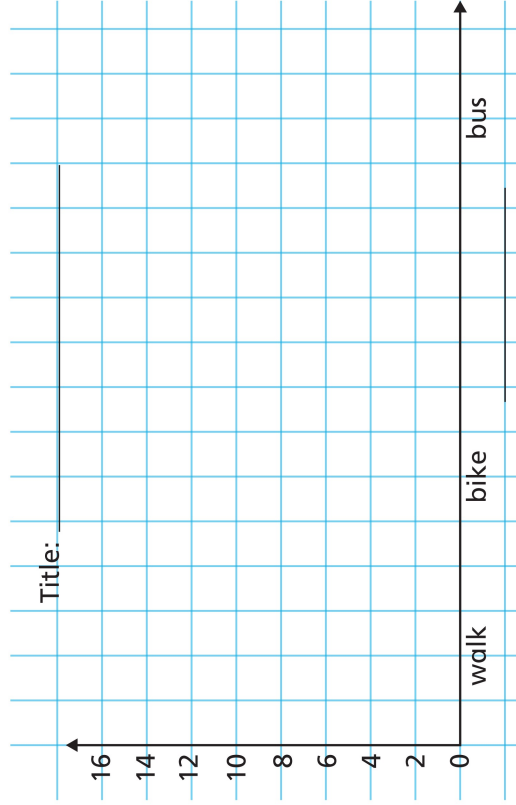

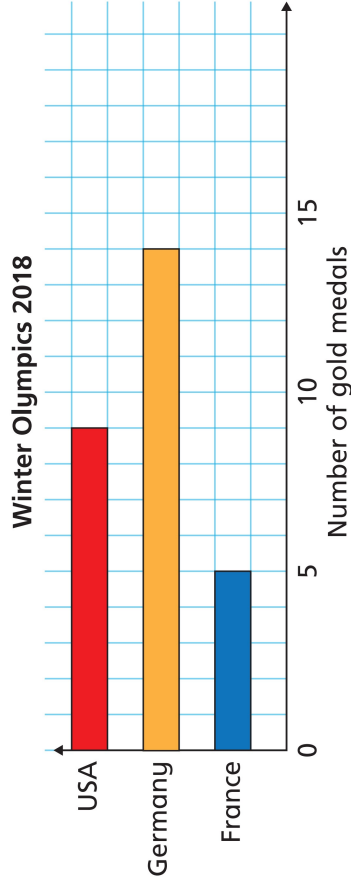
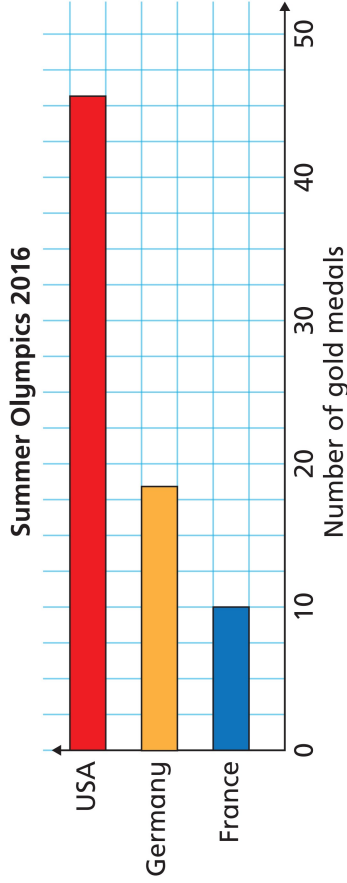
3 The pictogram shows the number of ice creams sold each day.

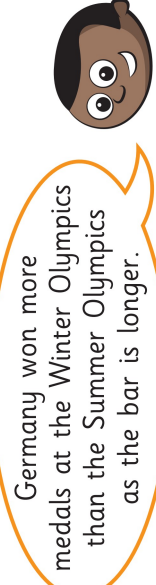
