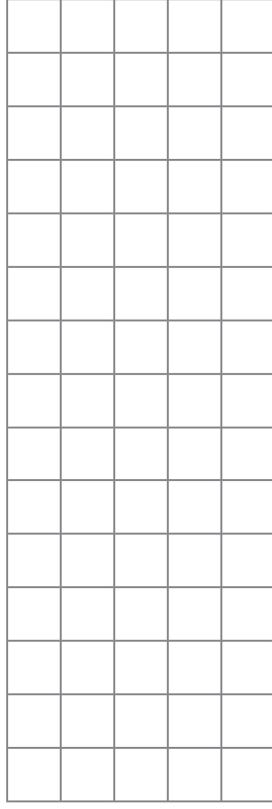
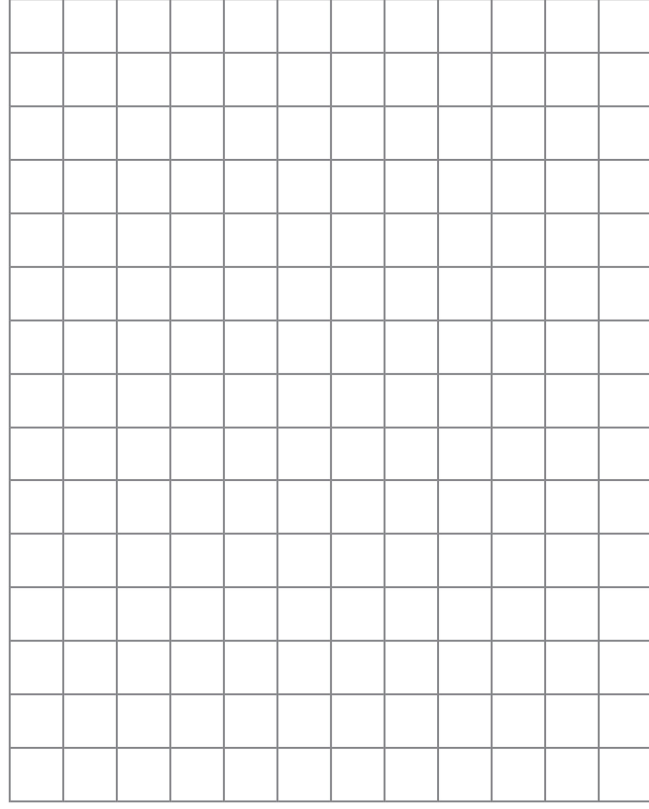

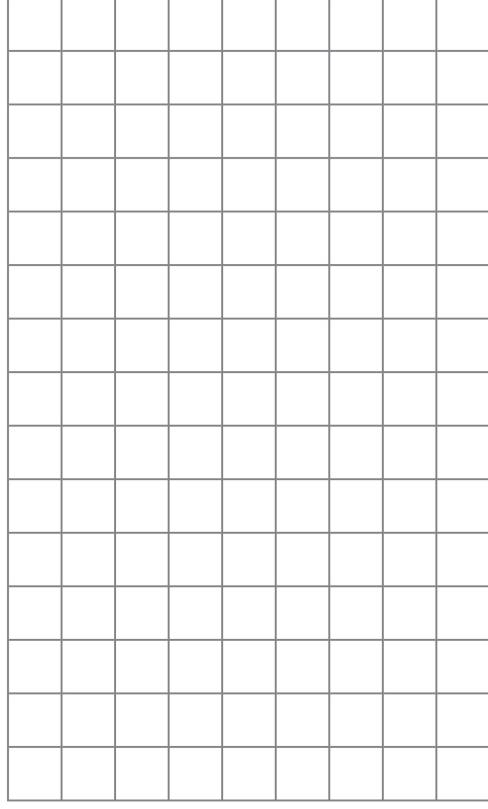
- 1 Draw two different squares.



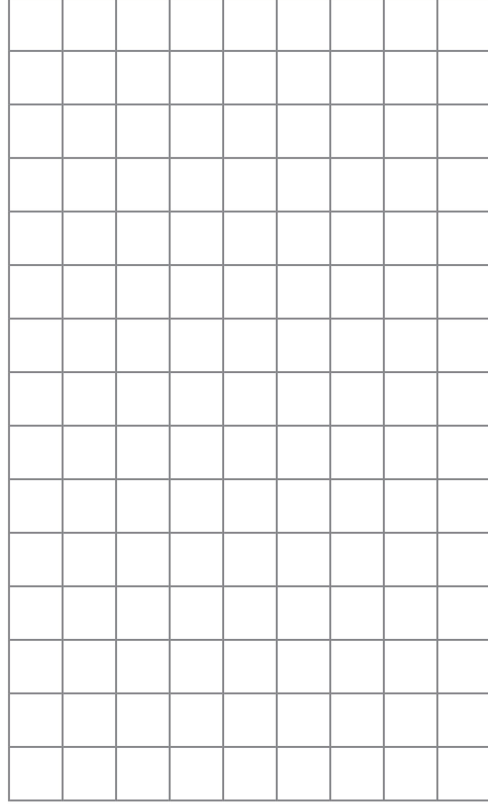
- 2 Draw three different rectangles.

- 4 Draw three different hexagons.



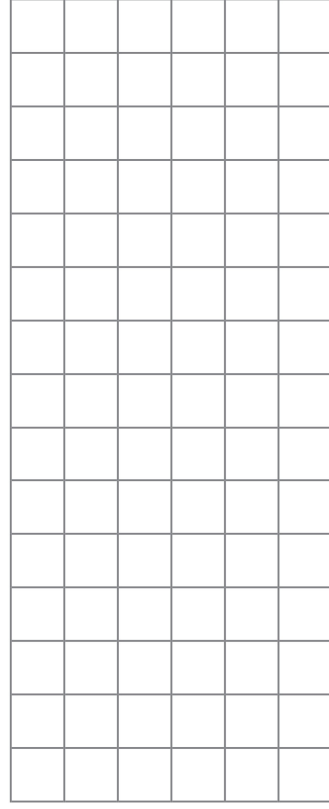

6 Annie is drawing a 2D shape.



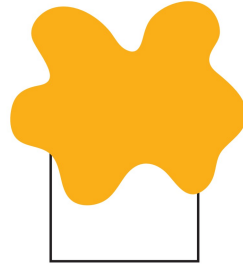
My shape has 5 vertices.

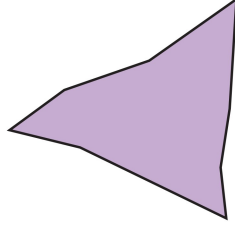

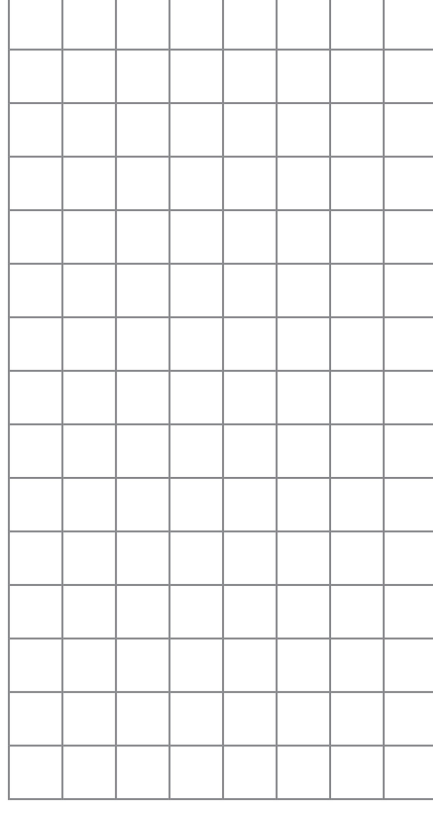
