







# SPEECH, LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION NEEDS IN THE MAINSTREAM SECONDARY CLASSROOM

## **Workshop Objectives:**

This one-day workshop will focus on speech, language and communication difficulties and how they affect performance across the curriculum and beyond.

Attendees will learn about strategies for supporting students with a range of speech, language and communication needs (SLCN) – the most common SEN need type.

### **Workshop Content:**

Participants will learn how to identify and support students with speech, language and communication difficulties in school:

- Gain an understanding of the range of SLCN difficulties as identified by health professionals or through school's own observation and tracking systems
- Explore a range of resources and strategies available to facilitate the development of language and communication skills in children and young people
- Explore practical strategies and ideas to support learning, social and emotional needs and future development.
- Become familiar with good SLCN practice as detailed in Kent's Mainstream Core Standards document.
